Changes to the Everest School Skirt

Many of you have commented on the length, style and the mixture of skirts worn by the female students. Consequently, we have decided to introduce a new Everest school skirt from September 2018. The one that has been chosen and approved by the school council will be the only skirt allowed and be 'A' line in style with a single pleat in the front. The braid of purple at the bottom of the waistband must be seen when worn.

This skirt can be ordered from Stitch Design, <https://www.stitchdesign.co.uk> from the end of June ready for the start of the new school year in September. The prices are as follows:

Please note that from waist size 30", VAT at 20% will be added by the retailer

The only alternative to wearing the new skirt will be traditional style black trousers (not skinny tight-fitting, denim, leggings or leggings style). Please see overleaf. Any student that refuses to adhere to this and any other items on the uniform policy will be removed from lessons. We will continue to hold a stock of suitable trousers that students who are incorrectly attired will have to wear.

Any female student, who would be more comfortable in a skirt and is eligible for free school meals, can contact the school office to discuss how we may be able to contribute towards the cost.

We appreciate that the cost of the new school skirt is higher than the previous one available, but this is an essential part of our strategy to raise standards further at the school.
